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## About the Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME)

The Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME) is a United Nations-supported initiative founded in 2007 that aims to raise the profile of sustainability in their classrooms through Seven Principles focused on serving society and safeguarding our planet.

PRME engages business and management schools to ensure they provide future leaders with the skills needed to balance economic and sustainability goals, while drawing attention to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and aligning academic institutions with the work of the UN Global Compact. Driven by its mission to transform management education, PRME equips today's business students with the understanding and ability to deliver change tomorrow. As a voluntary initiative with over 800 signatories worldwide, PRME has become the largest organized relationship between the United Nations and management-related higher education institutions.

## The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

In September 2015, all 193 Member States of the United Nations adopted a plan for achieving a better future for all – laying out a path over the next 15 years to end extreme poverty, fight inequality and injustice, and protect our planet. At the heart of Agenda 2030 are 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and 169 related targets that address the most important economic, social, environmental and governance challenges of our time. The SDGs clearly define the world we want – applying to all nations and leaving no one behind. Successful implementation of the SDGs will require all players to champion this agenda; the role of higher education is critical to this.

JSBE's strategic priorities for 2025–2028 strongly align with advancing **sustainable development**, the **common good**, and **quality education** through several integrated approaches:

#### 1. Advancing Sustainable Development

JSBE embeds sustainability across its mission, research, and education:

Sustainable Business and Economy is one of JSBE's strategic focus areas. JSBE has been a global pioneer in integrating sustainability into business education since the 1980s and it offers internationally recognized Master's degree programs like Corporate Environmental Management and Responsible Management and Business of Sport. Our faculty and staff also actively contributes to and participate in JYU Wisdom which is the University's Resource Wisdom research community. JSBE publishes the *Electronic Journal of Business Ethics and Organization Studies*.

JSBE's commitments and partnerships highlight sustainability. We are an institutional partner of Responsible Research in Business & Management (RRBM) and a signatory member of the Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME). We align our research and courses with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and collect data on the alignment annually.

#### 2. Serving the Common Good

JSBE's mission emphasizes societal impact and ethical responsibility: "Contributing to competitive, digital, and sustainable transformation in business and economy." We focus on combining theory and practice to serve business, public organizations, and society. Based on data from Overton.io, our intellectual contributions are widely used by policymakers both domestically and internationally. JSBE has strong ties with local and national stakeholders, including alumni, businesses, and public institutions. We promote Science for Policy impact, organize stakeholder events and encourage open science and sharing of research data.

JSBE's core values are openness, trust, quality, and integrity. We promote ecological, social, cultural, and economic sustainability in all operations.

#### 3. Promoting Quality Education

JSBE is committed to delivering high-impact, inclusive, and future-oriented education. JSBE offers a wide range of programs from Bachelor to Executive MBA, including five international Master's degree programs and a new Bachelor's in Business Innovation and Sustainability (launching 2025). We emphasize interdisciplinary learning, digital skills, ethics, and employability.

JSBE's approach is student-centered. We focus on flexible learning paths, technology-enhanced learning, and student wellbeing. We have a high international student intake and provide support for integration into Finnish society. We also promote student mobility and global exposure.

JSBE's strategic Indicators track student progression, job placement (including international graduates in Finland), and feedback on wellbeing and learning outcomes. University level Education Council and JSBE's Education Committee focus on continuous improvement of our educational offering.

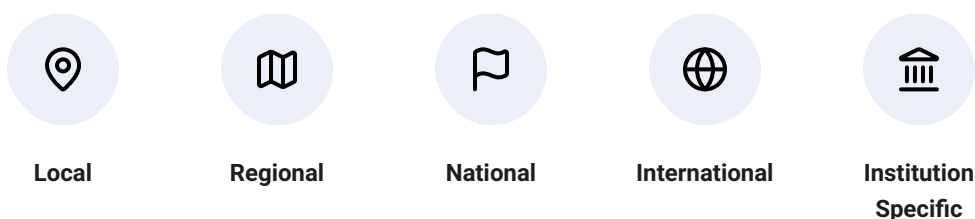
