The Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME) is a United Nationssupported initiative founded in 2007 that aims to raise the profile of sustainability in their classrooms through Seven Principles focused on serving society and safeguarding our planet.

PRME engages business and management schools to ensure they provide future leaders with the skills needed to balance economic and sustainability goals, while drawing attention to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and aligning academic institutions with the work of the UN Global Compact. Driven by its mission to transform management education, PRME equips today's business students with the understanding and ability to deliver change tomorrow. As a voluntary initiative with over 800 signatories worldwide, PRME has become the largest organized relationship between the United Nations and management-related higher education institutions.



How We Define Practice

The International School, Vietnam National University, Hanoi (VNU-IS) applies management principles and accountability through the establishment and implementation of transparent, effective management policies that meet international standards. These principles are carried out through specific steps as follows: Transparent and Open Management: VNU-IS ensures transparency in management activities, from curriculum development, admissions, to financial management and the use of resources. All relevant information is made public and easily accessible so that students, faculty, and stakeholders can monitor and supervise the activities. Ensuring Accountability: The school requires all departments, faculty members, and students to fulfill their responsibilities in the school's activities. The specialized departments, the school leadership, and management levels are accountable for the effectiveness of their work, while also being open to feedback from students and the academic community to improve operations. Regular Monitoring and Evaluation: VNU-IS conducts regular monitoring and evaluation of training activities, research, and student support services. These evaluation results not only help enhance teaching quality but also ensure the effectiveness and transparency of management decisions. Commitment to International Standards: The school applies international standards in educational management and research activities. This helps VNU-IS maintain competitiveness and stay updated with global educational trends, while also ensuring accountability to international organizations such as UNPRME and educational accreditation bodies. Creating Feedback Mechanisms and Continuous Improvement: VNU-IS provides channels for students and faculty to give feedback on issues related to learning and working. These feedbacks are reviewed and applied to improve policies and teaching methods, as well as enhance transparency and accountability in management. By applying these management principles and accountability measures, VNU-IS not only ensures the quality of education but also creates a professional and trustworthy learning environment for students.
